 Keukenhof is an historic park covering an area of thirty-two hectares, full of



April 23 Monday: Asparagus and Mushrooms

- The National Asparagus and Mushroom Museum.

Enjoy a guided tour of *Farmstead "De Locht*", a wonderful museum depicting farm life as it used to be. This is Holland's most important region (Limburg) for the production of both asparagus and mushrooms. The sandy soil is very suitable for asparagus. The museum shows how the vegetable is grown





and various special tools and implements used in the production and harvesting.

Continue to *Utrecht* for luncheon on your own.

The city of Utrecht was founded by the Romans in the year 50. It is located in the very heart of the Netherlands. Its rich history is visible around every corner of the historic centre.

Farewell Dinner in a traditional restaurant in old Utrecht.


Utrecht: Hotel N H Centre Utrecht
